REENROLLMENT FEE:

Early – \$225 per student through February 18, 2019 Regular – \$300 per student after February 18, 2019 Maximum per family – \$550

Early reenrollment extends through Monday, February 18, 2019; the early fee is \$225. After February 18, the regular fee is \$300. The maximum reenrollment fee per family is \$550. Current students receive reenrollment priority before February 18; space cannot be guaranteed after February 18. A student can be considered for reenrollment only after the non-refundable fee and form have been submitted.

NEW STUDENT ENROLLMENT FEE: \$300 per student. The non-refundable, \$300 per student enrollment fee is due at the time the new student application is submitted. The maximum enrollment fee per family is \$550.

ADDITIONAL FEES AND CHARGES

These additional fees and charges are based on the individual student and will be collected separately from tuition.

SCIENCE LABS: Lab courses include Biology, Chemistry, Physics and Anatomy & Physiology (high school only); money is collected by the finance office. A student incurs a fee for each lab course in which he is enrolled.

ACADEMIC TESTING FEES:

- **AP EXAMS: Each student enrolled in an AP course** will take an end-of-course exam published by The College Board. The fee is \$95.00 per exam and is collected directly by the instructor.
- **ACT ASPIRE: Each freshman and sophomore** will take this exam, which is designed to predict a student's score on the ACT college entrance exam. The fee is \$35.00 and is collected by the School Office.
- **PSAT: Each junior** will take this exam, which is used to determine eligibility for the National Merit Scholarship Program. The fee is \$20.00 and is collected by the School Office.

FINE ARTS ELECTIVES: These courses include Art, Band, Choir and/or Drama (middle school and high school only); student incurs only one fee even if enrolled in more than one Fine Arts class. **Fee is not prorated by number of days in class or by number of semesters enrolled.** Money is collected by the finance office.

• \$35.00/annually

KEYBOARDING: These middle school and high school courses are conducted in the WCA computer lab. The fee helps to offset additional equipment, maintenance and software licenses. **Fee is not prorated by number of days in class or by number of semesters enrolled.** Money is collected by the finance office.

• \$25.00/annually

FINANCIAL PEACE SEMINAR: Seniors use Dave Ramsey's Financial Peace University course to learn how money works and to make sound financial decisions for life. The fee covers workbooks and video site license; money is collected by the finance office.

• \$35.00/annually

MUSIC LESSONS: Areas of instruction include piano, instrumental or voice (all levels); money is collected directly by the music teacher.

• \$65.00/monthly

ATHLETIC PARTICIPATION (WCA SCHOOL TEAMS): This helps to cover coaching stipends and transportation; money is collected directly by the athlete's coach prior to the first game or scrimmage of the season.

Winter Sports: \$100.00 per athlete/\$200.00 max per family
Spring Sports: \$75.00 per athlete/\$150.00 max per family
